It is affiliated with the Iowa Community Affiliate Network, with added services from the Greater Des Moines Community Foundation. It is funded through a percentage of gaming revenues from the State of Iowa and from donations from individuals, foundations, and businesses interested in improving Marion County.

Donors can benefit from Endow Iowa legislation that provides substantial tax benefits for contributions to endowment for qualified Iowa community foundations. Donations may be earmarked for a specific cause, for endowment, for pass-through grants, or left to the discretion of the Foundation's Board of Directors.

An organization receiving a grant must qualify as a non-profit, 501(c)(3) tax exempt organization or a 170-B unit of Government and may be located anywhere within Marion County.

Grants are awarded by the Foundation for projects that will benefit citizens of all ages and in all areas of Marion County. Categories funded include arts and culture, education, human services, community betterment, health and recreation, and youth development.
